RULES FOR THE TASK:

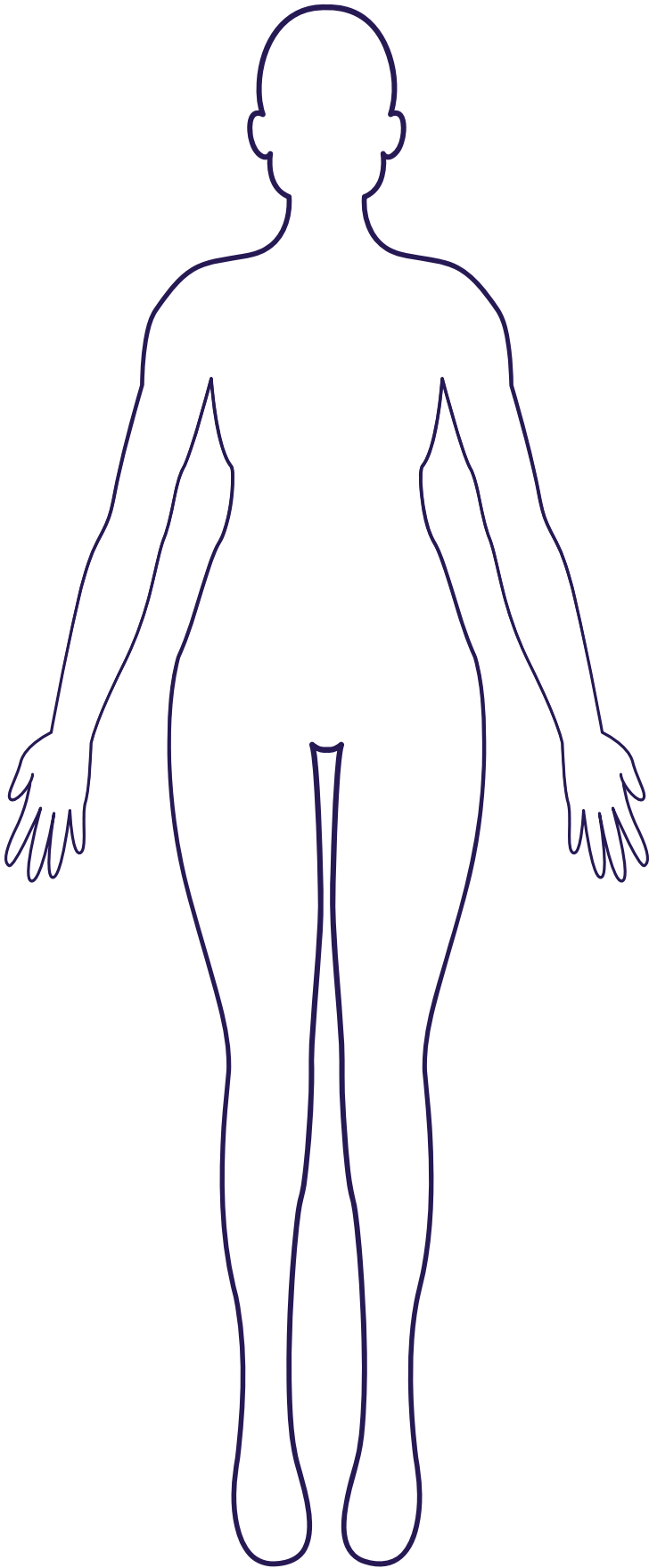
Choose clothing and food items only made from Agriculture products, like cotton for shirts or milk for a cheese sandwich.

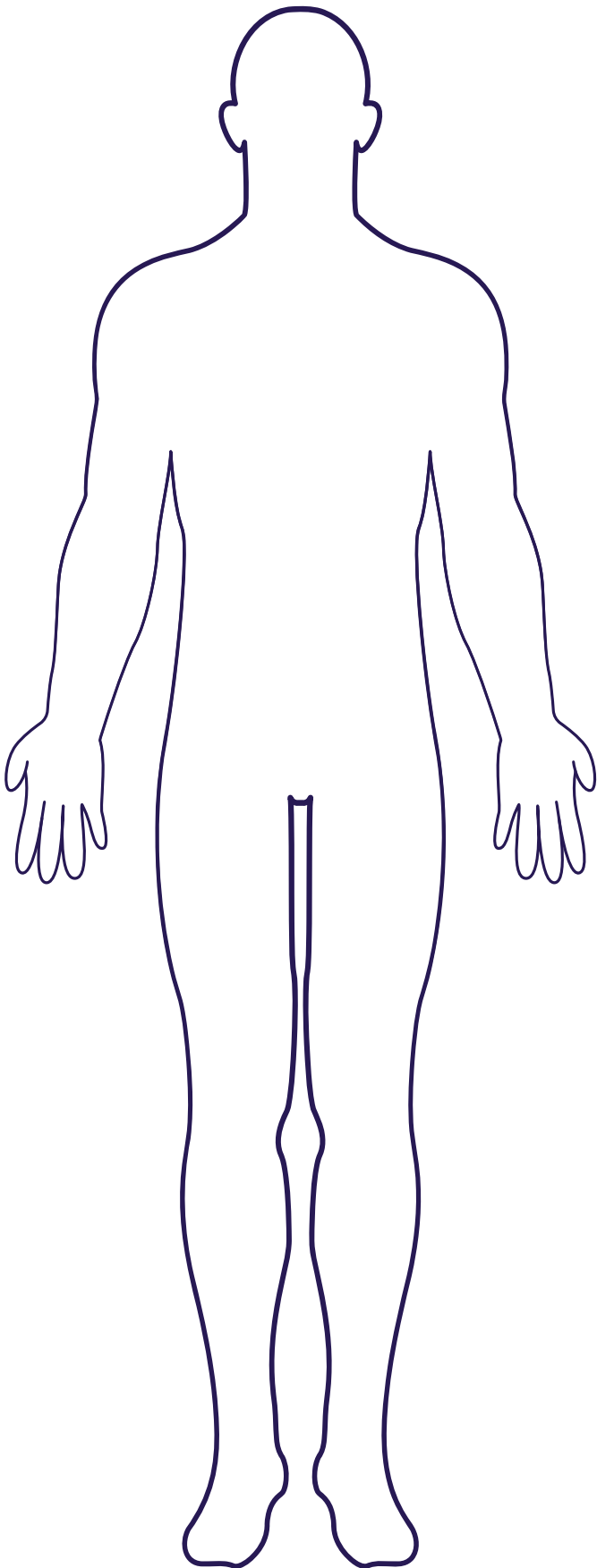

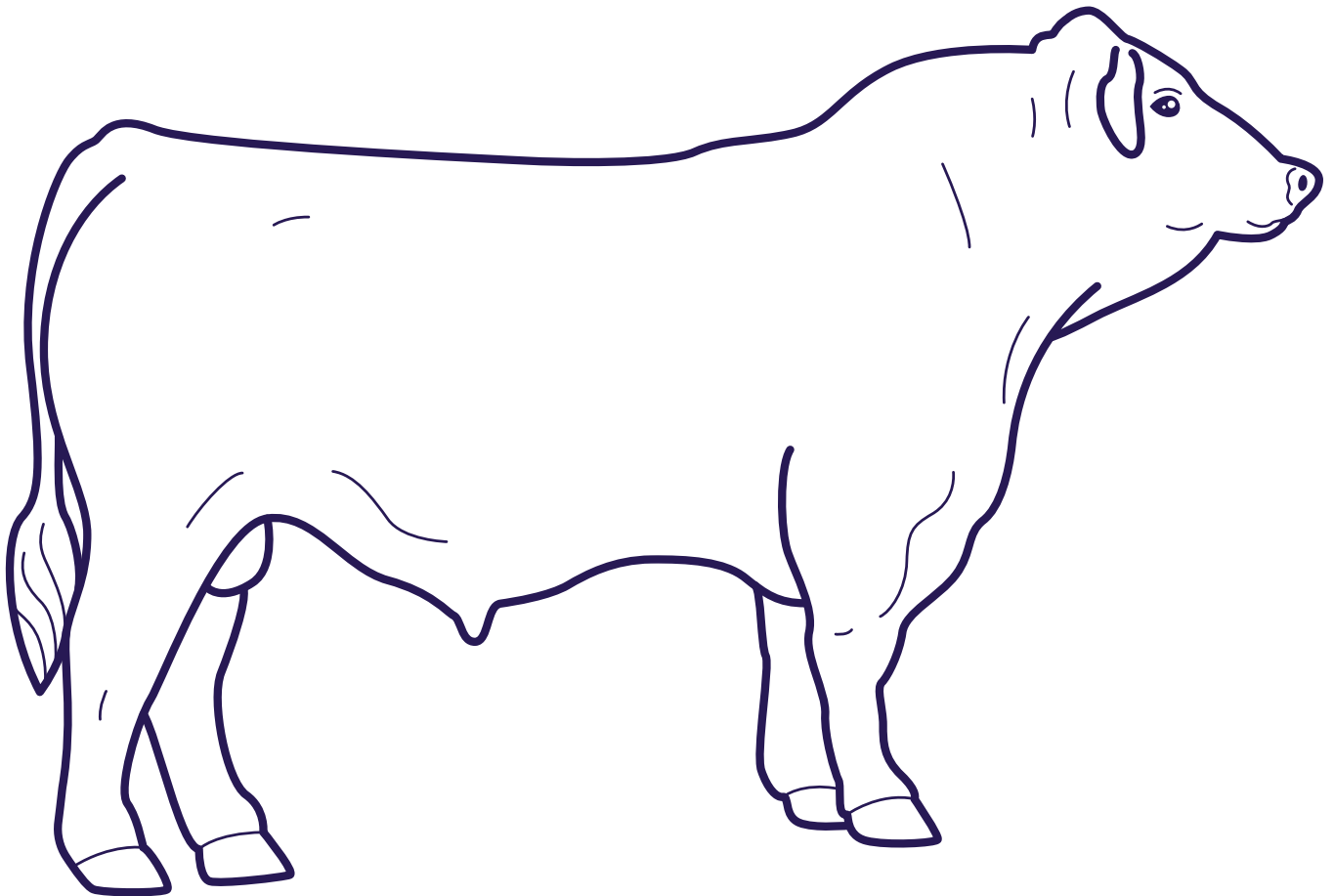


STUD BULL ARNOLD

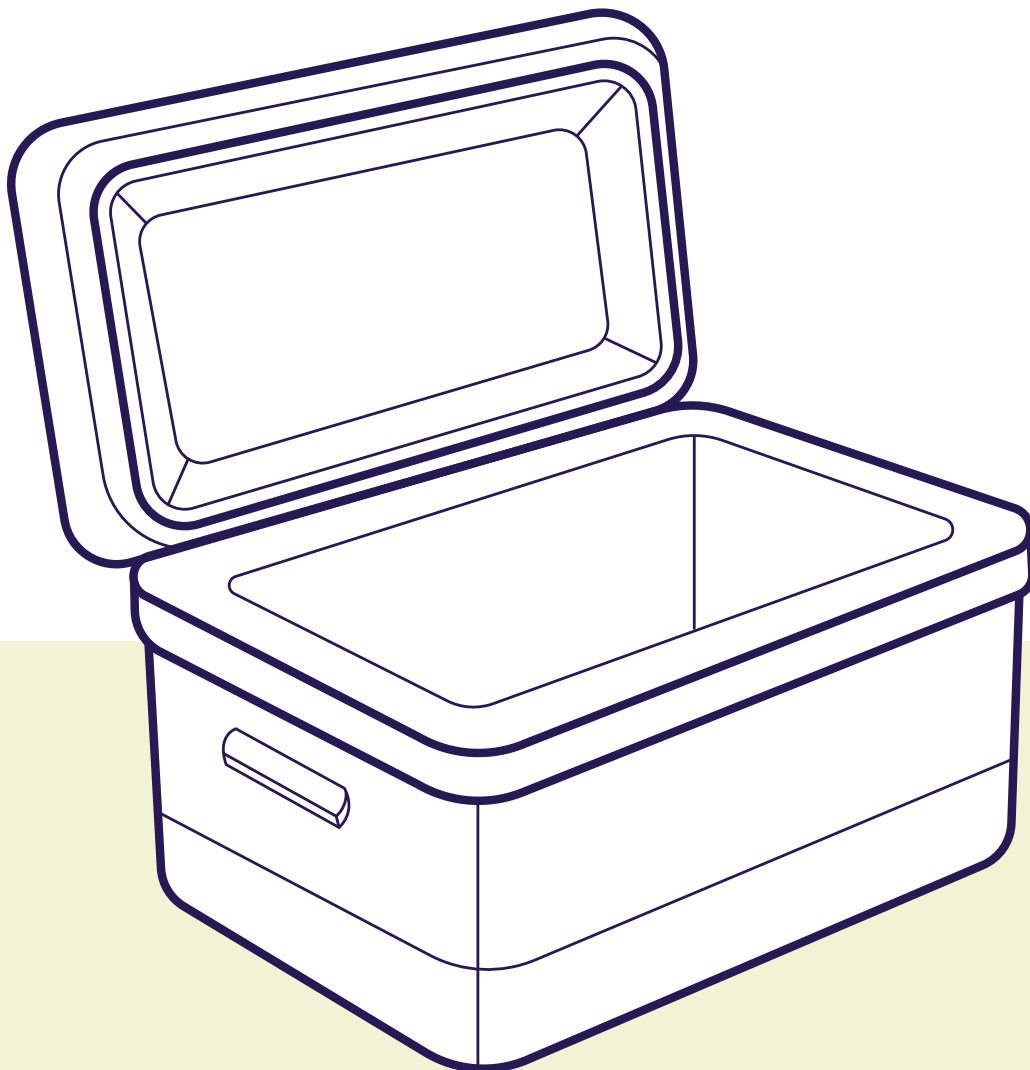
