



Terms & Conditions & Conditions of Sale for Schools Program Tickets at the 2025 Sydney Royal Easter Show

Conditions of use

The Royal Agricultural Society of NSW /as Sydney Royal Easter Show ('RAS') is responsible for the website and on-line purchasing facility on www.eastershow.com.au.

By clicking 'Accept' you agree that you have read and understand the following conditions which apply to your purchase of Schools Program Tickets:

1. Purchase of School Tickets and Sessions are only available to 'Schools' defined as NSW and ACT public schools and any school that appears on the following lists:
 - a. NSW 'List of Registered Non-Government Schools in New South Wales':

2. These Terms and Conditions apply to both the original purchaser and any subsequent ticketholders.
3. The RAS may vary these Terms and Conditions from time to time by updating them. Any variations will only apply to ticket purchases made after these Terms



and Conditions have been updated. It is your responsibility to make sure you have reviewed and agree and accept to the most updated Terms and Conditions.

Ticketing

4. Student Tickets:

- a. The School agrees to pay on behalf of each student attending the Sydney Royal Easter Show through the Schools Program.
- b. This Student ticket must be used for entry on the day the student attends with the school group.
- c. A student ticket for a Schools Program Ticket is \$20 per student and is GST-exempt (“Student Ticket Fee”).
- d. A Student ticket for the Food Technology Workshops is an additional \$15 Ticket per student and is GST-inclusive (“Student Ticket Fee”).
- e. This Teacher ticket must be used for entry on the day the Teacher attends with the school group or on the designated day they have booked in for the Teacher Professional Development.
- f. A Teacher ticket for a Schools Program Ticket is \$20 per teacher and is GST-inclusive.
- g. A Teacher ticket for the Teacher Professional Development session is an additional \$20 per teacher and is GST-inclusive.

5. Home-school Tickets:

- a. Home-school tickets can only be purchased by large groups exceeding 10 students.

6. The school / ticketholder must not resell, or offer for resale, tickets or vouchers for profit or commercial gain. If this occurs, the ticket holder will be refused entry and the ticket cancelled. Ticket sale legislation can impose criminal penalties.



7. Ownership of the tickets passes from when the RAS emails the tickets, the RAS will not issue replacements for lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed tickets.
8. Tickets must be kept in a good condition as the RAS may refuse entry for damaged or defaced tickets.
9. The RAS offers a Pay Later scheme on-line. 'Pay Later' tickets will be held for a maximum of 7 days. If payment is not received by the RAS within 7 days of the order placement, the tickets will not be issued and the order (including bookings) will be cancelled.
10. The RAS accepts payment by the following methods: -
 - Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)
 - Credit cards
 - Business or company cheques
 - Pre-payment through the LMBR system
11. The RAS does not accept AMEX or Diners Club Credit Cards. No personal cheques will be accepted. By submitting payment on this website, the buyer confirms they are either the authorised card holder or has the express consent of the cardholder.
12. RAS will not accept returns, exchanges or refunds unless required by law or at the RAS' sole discretion. Claims for refund must be received by the RAS Schools Program Coordinator 24hrs before excursion date.
13. Tickets are non-transferable and can only be used for the booked date.
14. The RAS reserves the right to change the advertised program, price, venue, access to certain areas or reschedule Sydney Royal Easter Show.
15. Unless required by law, the RAS will not be liable for any other losses incurred by the school / ticketholder as a result of the cancellation, rescheduling or relocation of the Easter show, including any travel and accommodation expenses.



16. Without limiting other remedies it may have, the RAS may limit, cancel, suspend, or refuse entry to school / ticketholder who are acting inconsistently with these Terms and Conditions or the Conditions of Entry to the Sydney showground.
17. Teacher Pack and forms.
 - a. The school / ticketholder must complete all required documents prior to the Easter Show. Required documents include, but are not limited to, the Teacher Pack and all forms in the Teacher Pack.
 - b. The RAS assumes that, and the school / ticketholder represents that, the documents and forms completed by the school / ticketholder The RAS will not be liable for, and the school / ticketholder agrees to hold the RAS harmless, for any inaccurate and incomplete forms.
18. As part of the school / ticketholder participation at the Easter Show, unless otherwise expressly specified in any document or form submitted by the school / ticketholder, the school / ticketholder gives permission to be photographed and filmed by the RAS and agrees that the photograph and film may be used at the RAS, at its discretion, in print, television, online, and in social media channels.
